

PRIVACY POLICY

Pursuant to d.lgs. 196/2003 and Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter "Regulation"), this page describes the methods for processing the personal data of users who consult the website accessible electronically at the following address: <https://www.3dmsrl.com>.

We inform the user that following consultation of this site, data relating to identified or identifiable persons may be processed.

This information does not concern other sites, pages or online services accessible via hypertext links that may be published on the site.

Identity of the Data Controller

The data controller is 3DM Costruzioni Meccaniche S.R.L., in the person of its legal representative pro tempore with registered office in Via Oleifici Dell'Italia Meridionale S.N. - 70056 Molfetta (BA), (Email: info@3dmsrl.com, PEC: 3dmsrl@legalmail.it).

Source of data and type of data collected

1) Data provided by the User

The Data Controller collects personal data provided by users:

when sending a message voluntarily using the contact addresses on the <https://www.3dmsrl.com>.

The optional and voluntary sending of messages to the contact addresses on the site, involves the acquisition of the sender's contact data necessary to provide feedback, as well as all personal data included in communications.

2) Navigation data

The Data Controller collects data relating to the use of the website by the user.

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this site acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of computers and terminals used by users, addresses in URI / URL (Uniform Resource Identifier / Locator) notation of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

These data, necessary for the use of web services, are also processed for the purpose of:

- obtain statistical information on the use of the services (most visited pages, number of visitors by time or day, geographical areas of origin, etc.);
- check the correct functioning of the services offered.

The navigation data do not persist for more than seven days and are deleted immediately after their aggregation (except for any need to ascertain crimes by the judicial authority).

3) Cookies and other tracking systems

In order to make our services as efficient and easy to use as possible, this Site uses cookies.

Therefore, when visiting the Site, a minimum amount of information is placed on the User's device, such as small text files called "cookies", which are saved in the User's web browser directory. There are different types of cookies, but basically the main purpose of a cookie is to make the Site work more effectively and to enable certain features.

Purpose of the processing

Depending on the type of processing to be carried out, the Data Controller uses the data collected and / or provided by the User for the following purposes:

- 1) provide feedback to any communications, requests for information and / or services from users by sending a message using the contact addresses on the site;
- 2) manage and control risks, prevent possible fraud, insolvency or default; prevent and manage possible disputes, take legal action in case of need.

Legal basis of the processing

With reference to the purposes indicated in the previous paragraph, the legal basis of the same is, with regard to the point:

- 1) the need to execute a contract of which the interested party is a party or pre-contractual measures adopted at the request of the same;
- 2) the need to pursue the legitimate interest of the data controller (in particular with regard to the prevention of fraud and insolvencies).

Recipients of the data

The personal data processed by the Data Controller are not disseminated, or are not disclosed to indeterminate subjects, in any possible form, including that of making them available or simple consultation.

Instead, they can be communicated to workers who work for the Data Controller as they operate under the authority of the data controller. On the basis of the roles and work tasks performed, these workers have been entitled to process personal data, taking into account their respective skills and in accordance with the instructions given to them by the Data Controller.

The Owner has appointed third-party service providers in connection with the operation of the Website, such as hosting service providers, IT maintenance service providers, as well as service providers that allow the integration into the Website of other functions that the User can use at his discretion.

These service providers, designated as Data Processors, are provided only with the personal data necessary to provide the corresponding services and are not allowed to use or disclose the personal data of the interested parties for other purposes, without the prior authorization of the interested party.

Finally, the data may be communicated to persons entitled to access it by virtue of legal provisions, regulations, community regulations.

Data transfer

Under no circumstances does the Data Controller transfer personal data to third countries or to international organizations.

Data retention

The Data Controller retains and processes personal data for the time necessary to fulfill the purposes indicated. Subsequently, personal data will be stored and not further processed, for the time established by the current civil and tax provisions.

In the event of any litigation, the data collected will be kept for the entire duration of the same, until the terms of practicability of the appeal actions are exhausted.

It should also be added that, in the event that a user provides the Data Controller with personal data not requested or not necessary for the execution of the requested service or for the provision of a service closely connected to it, 3DM Costruzioni Meccaniche S.R.L. cannot be considered the owner of these data, and will delete them as soon as possible.

Rights of the interested party

In relation to the data subject to the processing referred to in this statement, the interested party is entitled at any time to:

- ask the Data Controller for access to your personal data and information relating to them (Article 15 of the GDPR); the correction of inaccurate data or the integration of incomplete data (Article 16 of the GDPR); the cancellation of personal data concerning you (upon the occurrence of one of the conditions indicated in Article 17, paragraph 1 of the GDPR and in compliance with the exceptions provided for in paragraph 3 of the same article); the limitation of the processing of your personal data (in the event of one of the hypotheses indicated in Article 18, paragraph 1 of the GDPR);
- request and obtain from the Data Controller - in cases where the legal basis of the processing is the contract or consent, and the same is carried out by automated means - your personal data in a structured and machine-readable format, also in order to communicate such data to another data controller (so-called right to the portability of personal data - Article 20 of the GDPR);
- oppose at any time the processing of your personal data to the occurrence of particular situations that concern you (Article 21 of the GDPR);

The appropriate request is presented by contacting the Data Controller via PEC at the 3dmsrl@legalmail.it address, e-mail at info@3dmsrl.com address or registered letter with return receipt to the address Via Oleifici Dell'Italia Meridionale S.N. - 70056 Molfetta (BA).

The interested party, if he considers that the processing of his data is in violation of the provisions of the Regulation, may lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Authority for the protection of personal data – www.garanteprivacy.it), as required by art. 77 of the GDPR, or take the appropriate judicial offices (art. 79 of the GDPR).

Refusal to provide data

In the event that the interested party does not provide his data identified as necessary for the execution of the requested service, the Data Controller will not be able to follow up the treatments related to the management of the aforementioned service, nor to the obligations that depend on it.

Automated decision-making

The Data Controller does not carry out treatments that consist of automated decision-making processes on the data of natural persons.
